

PLEASE BE A RESPECTFUL NEIGHBOR!

Since HIW is NOT a resort but is rather a condominium, everyone must be aware and sensitive to the many other many residents who live here full or part time. All our residents have the right to feel at home and able to enjoy peace within their homes and our common areas.

Also, our HIW Vision expresses that we all promote cooperation. So, we ask you to please cooperate with your neighbors to reduce the noises and sounds in your condo.

(That said, we also acknowledge that residents occasionally make repairs and hammer or have acceptable and temporary remodeling for a set period of time.)

Here are some TIPS to reduce noises above and below, as well as, sounds carrying sideways: PLEASE,

- 1. On all hard surface flooring, always wear soft soled shoes or no shoes.
- 2. Try placing carpet runners or area carpets on the hard surface floors to minimize noises.
- 3. Keep your voices, musical instruments, stereo and television volumes at a low level especially if your sliding doors or windows are open. Watch the volume of the BASS as it thumps through the concrete.
- 4. Do not slam front or cupboard doors. Those loud noises transmit to your neighbors. Contact the manager's office, if you require front door adjustment.
- 5. Do not jump, roll chairs, or run across the floor (even toddlers), those noises are jarring.
- 6. Play ball with children and pets outside, because the sound of the balls and the scrabbling of dogs running can be heard by others.
- 7. Control your dog so that it does not bark often or continually.
- 8. Place felt, Teflon or rubber tips on all legs and feet of furniture on hard surface floors.
- 9. Use all noisy machines, disposals etc. during regular daytime hours.
